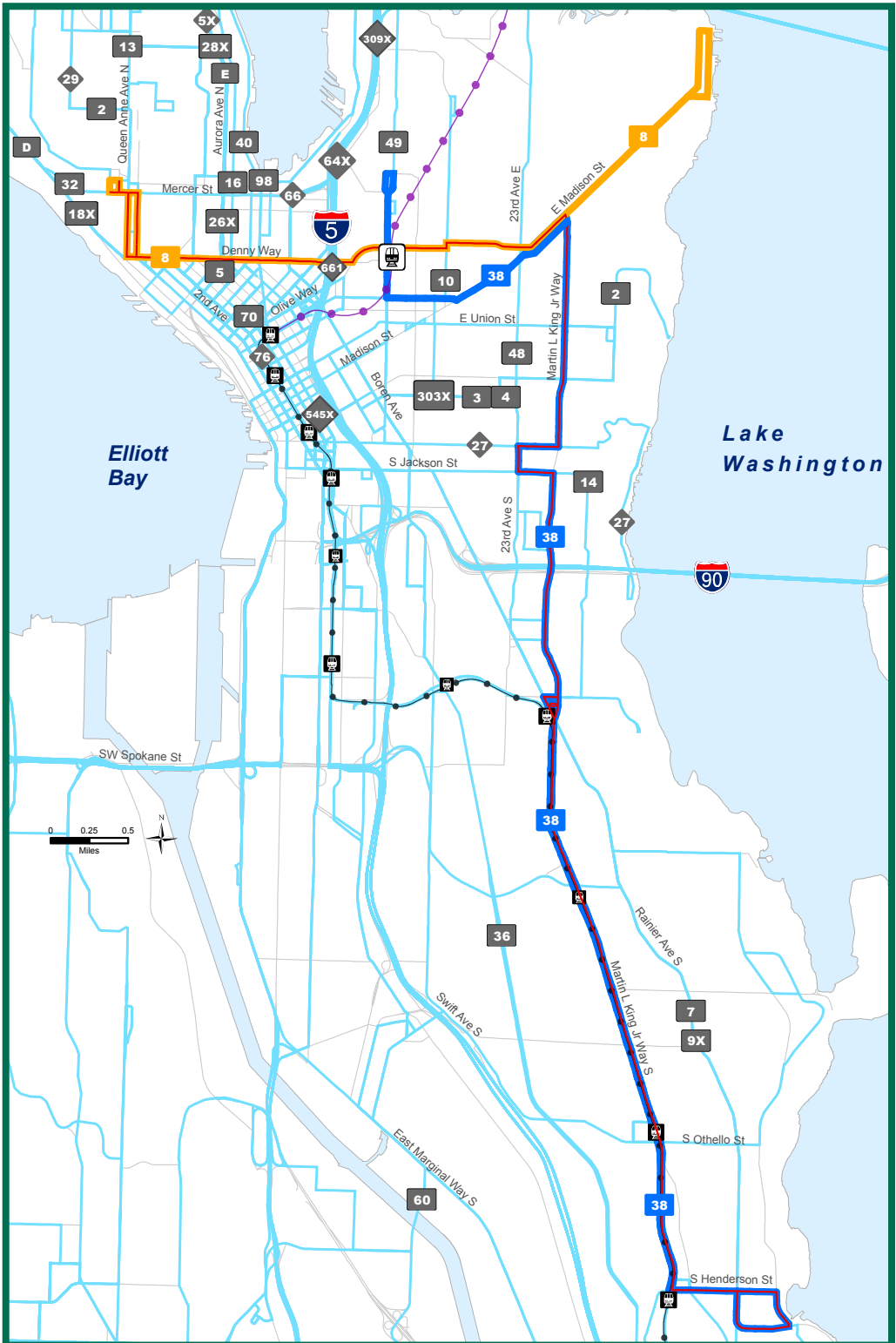
Rider options
