Summary of recommended changes

- Shorten Route 8 to run between the Mount Baker Transit Center and the Seattle Center to improve reliability.
- Buses would come more often on weekdays.
- Rename the southern part of Route 8, between Rainier Beach and Mount Baker, as new Route 38.
- Revise Route 8 to run along E Madison Street and 19th Avenue E instead of E Thomas Street between 24th Avenue E and 19th Avenue E.
- Extend service by one hour on Saturday and Sunday nights.
- This route would have improved service thanks to Seattle voters.

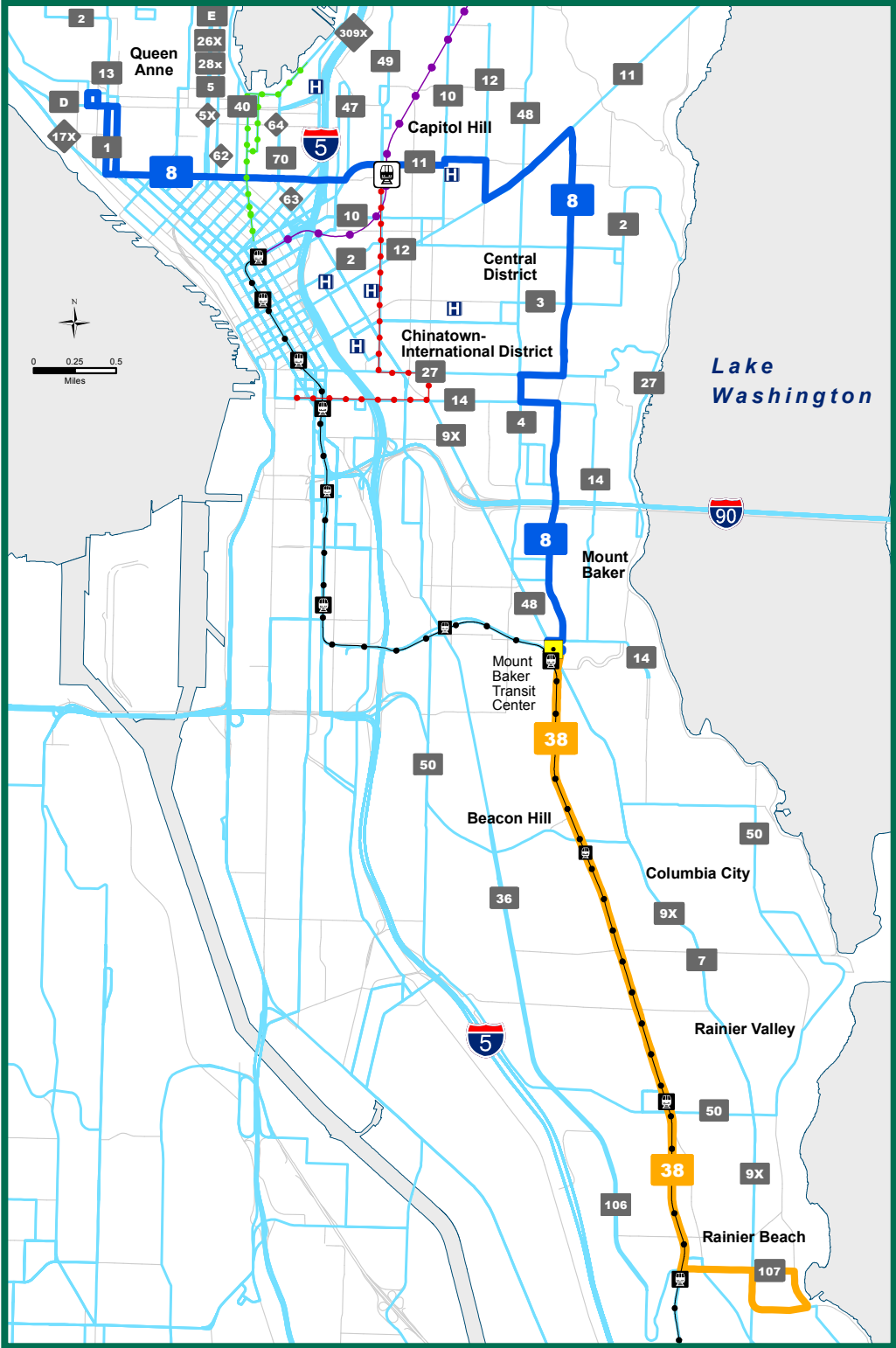
