- This route would have improved service thanks to Seattle voters.

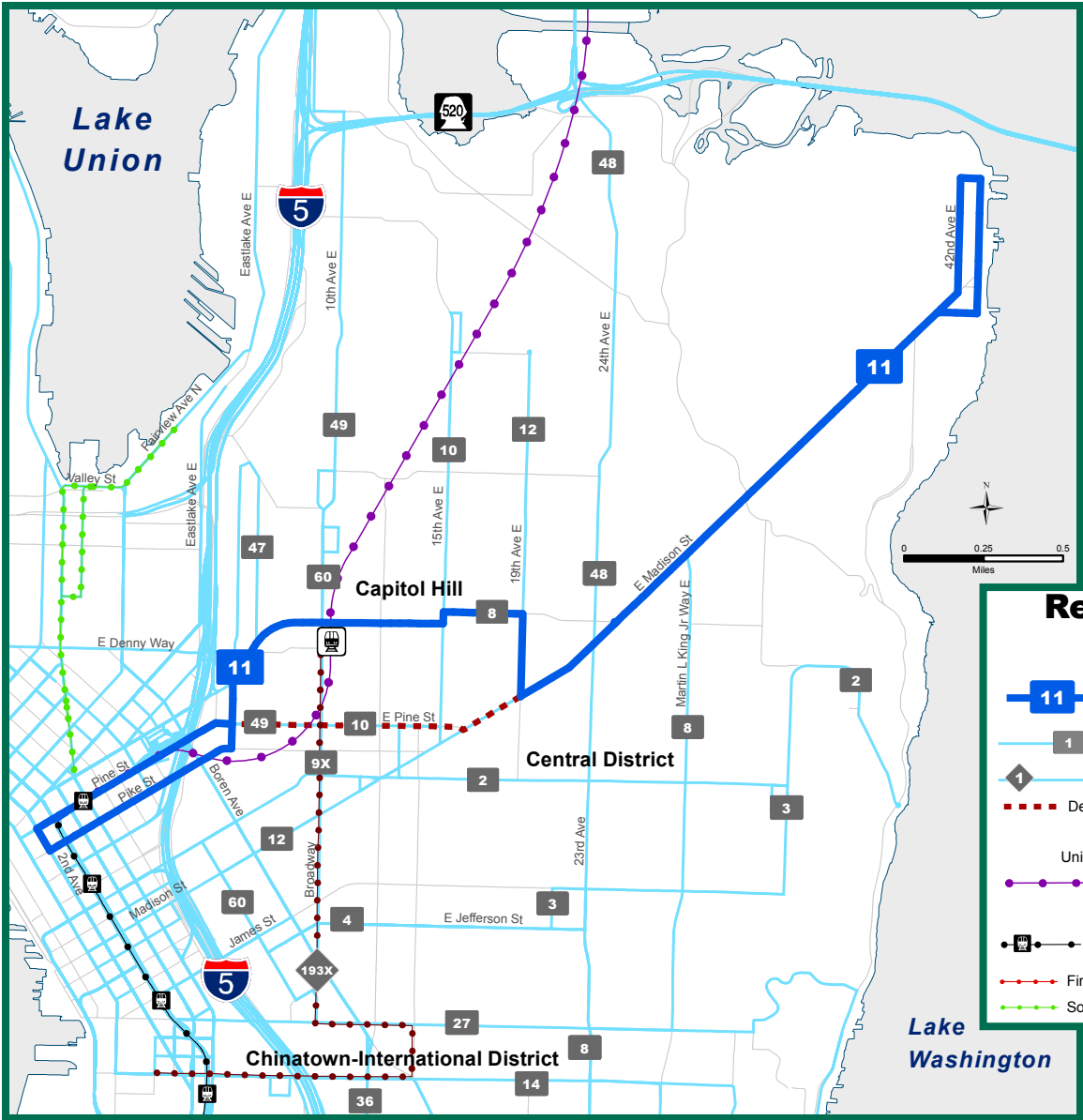
