Current: Broadview - downtown Seattle Adopted: (Broadview) Carkeek Park - downtown Seattle

Summary of adopted changes

- Combine routes 28 and 28X to make the system more efficient.
- Follow a revised express pathway to downtown Seattle via N 39th Street and Aurora Avenue N.
- Operate all day on weekdays and weekends.
- Provide service between Broadview and Carkeek Park during peak periods only.




