Summary of adopted changes

- New Route 38 will replace Route 8 between Rainier Beach and the Mount Baker Transit Center to improve reliability.
- In 2015, trips were added on Route 8, thanks to Seattle voters. These added trips will be maintained on Route 38 in March 2016.

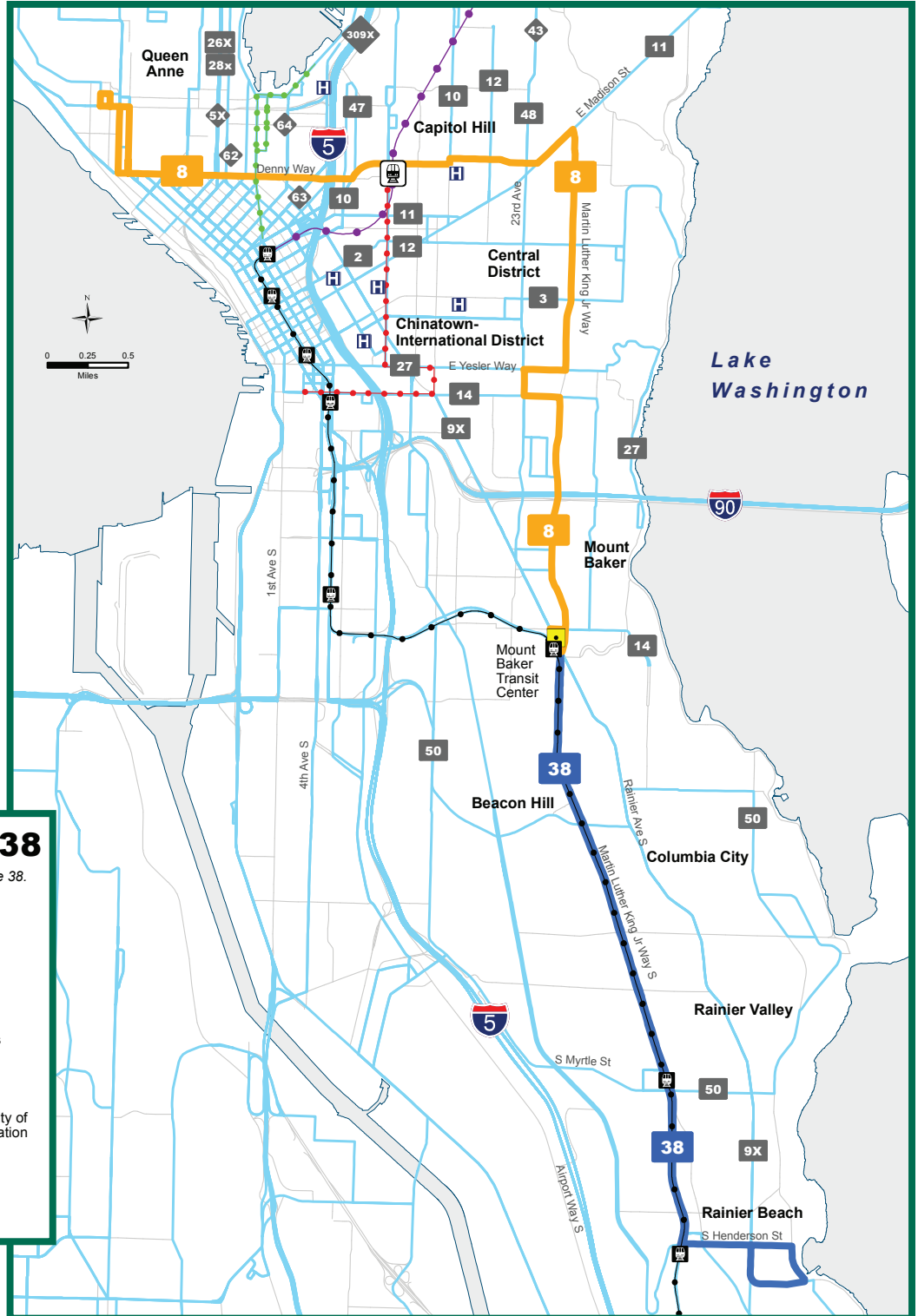
