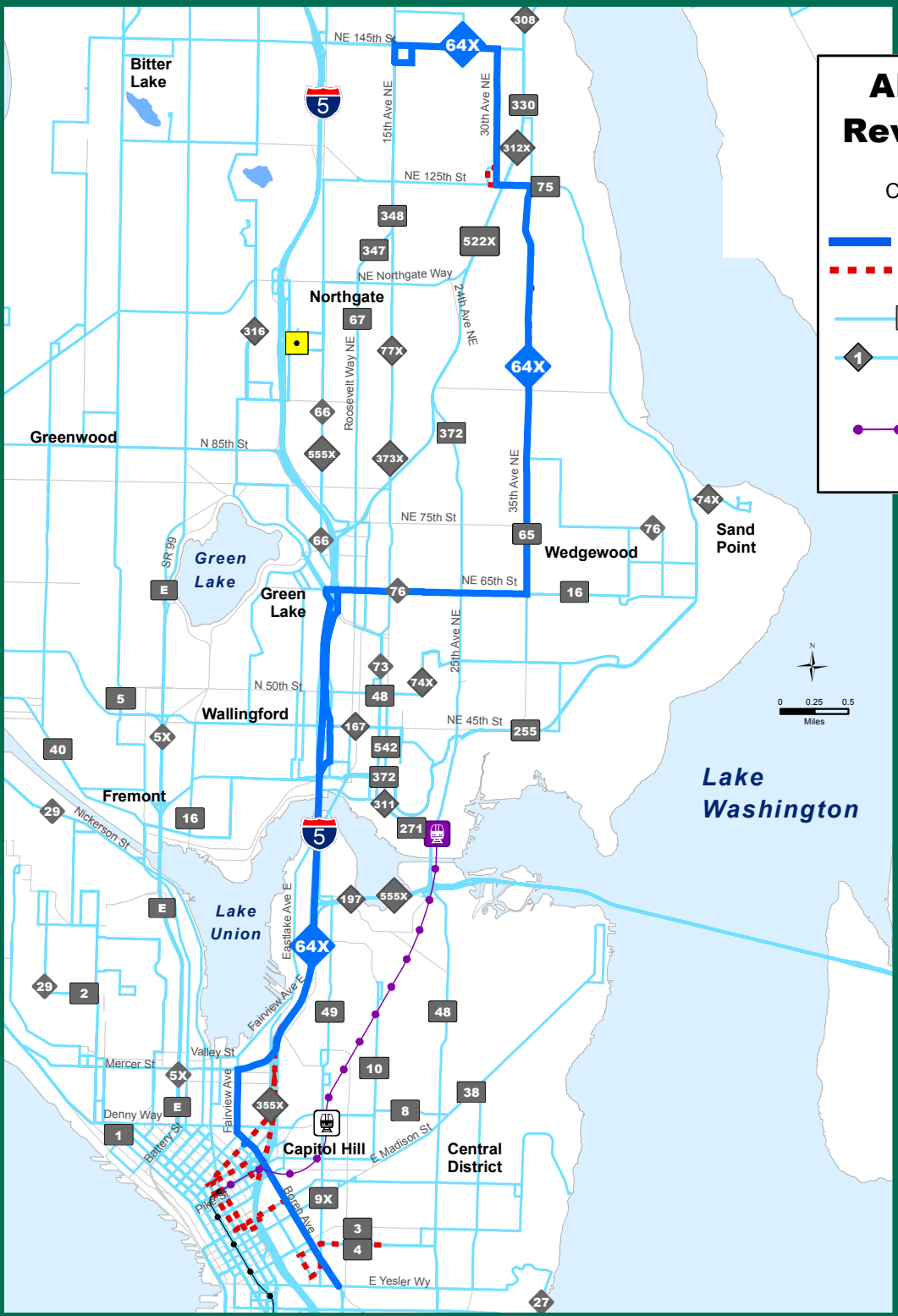
- To reach 4th Avenue or 5th Avenue, use routes 76 or 316.
