Summary of changes

Alternative 1

- Operate only during peak periods and only between Roosevelt and downtown Seattle to reduce duplication and improve reliability.

Alternative 2

- Revise to travel between Northgate, the University District, and downtown Seattle. Use Roosevelt Way NE north of NE Ravenna Boulevard.

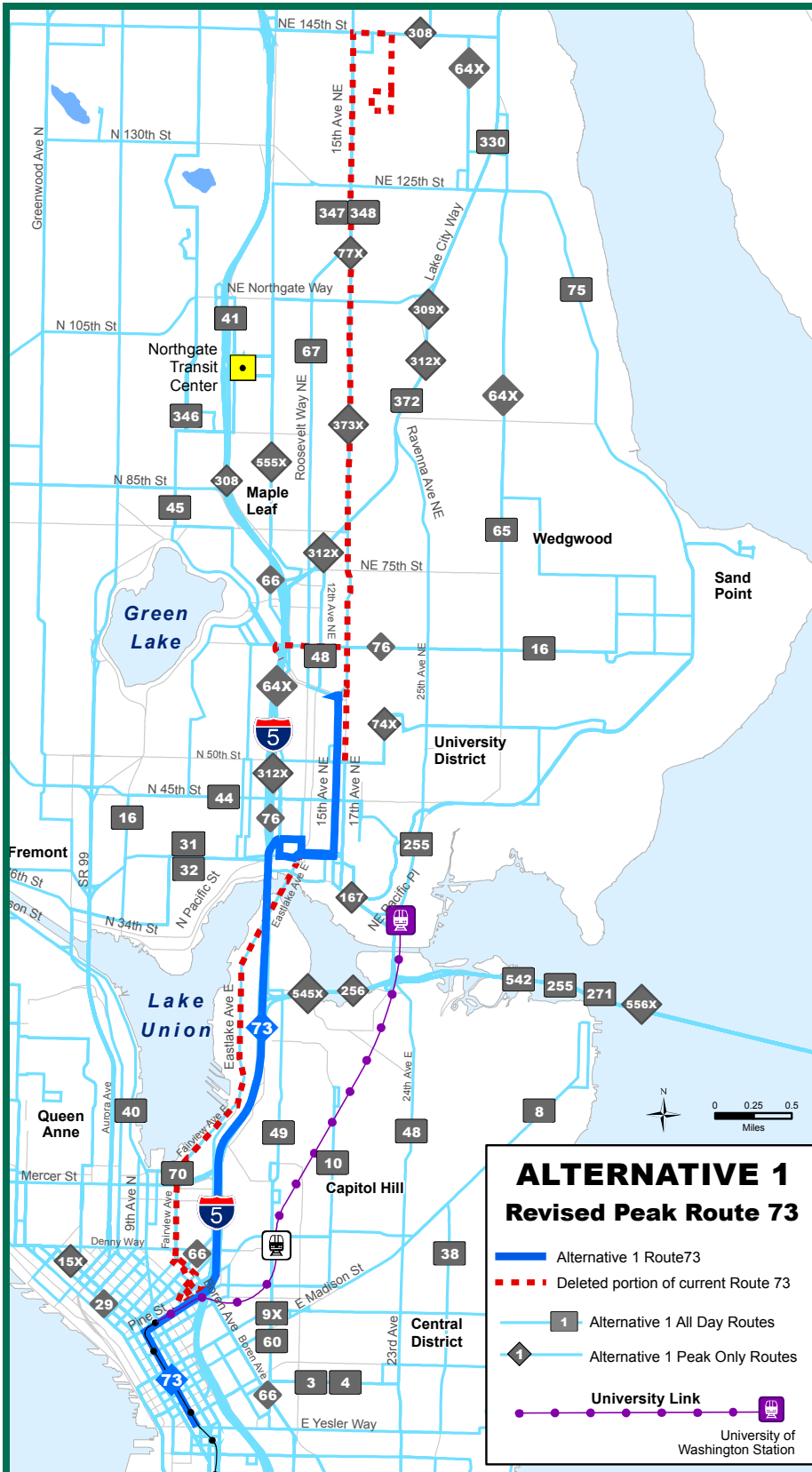

- North of NE Northgate Way, use routes 347, 348, or 373.



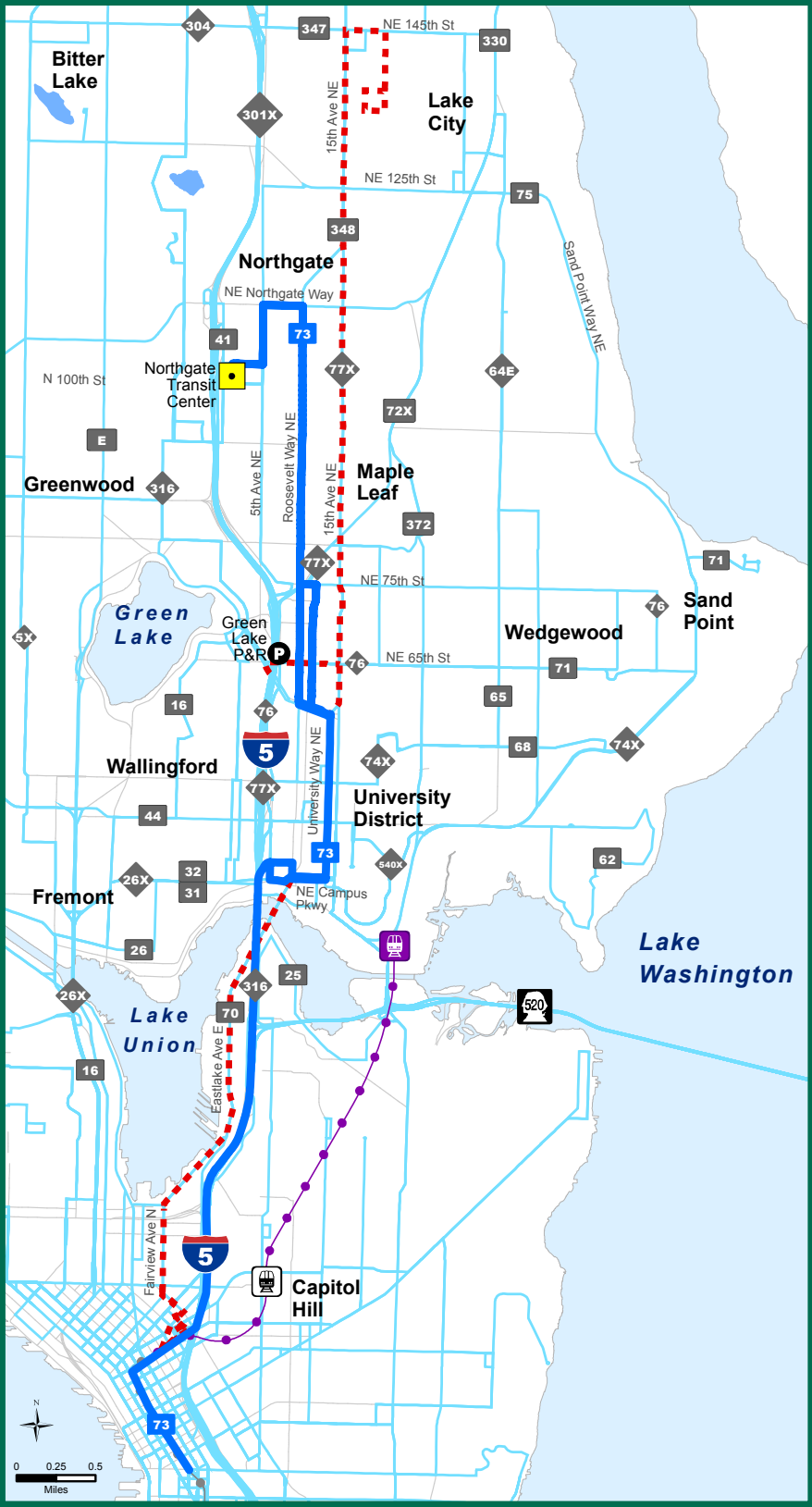
