73	Current: Jackson Park - downtown Seattle Recommended: Jackson Park - University District

Summary of recommended changes

- Operate Route 73 on weekdays between Jackson Park and the University of Washington campus.
- Between NE 65th Street and NE Campus Parkway, revise Route 73 to serve 11th Avenue NE and Roosevelt Way NE to replace routes 66X and 67.
- Through-route Route 73 with new Route 78.
- Reduce hours of service on weekdays.
- Eliminate weekend service.
- Weeknight service would have improved frequency thanks to Seattle voters.

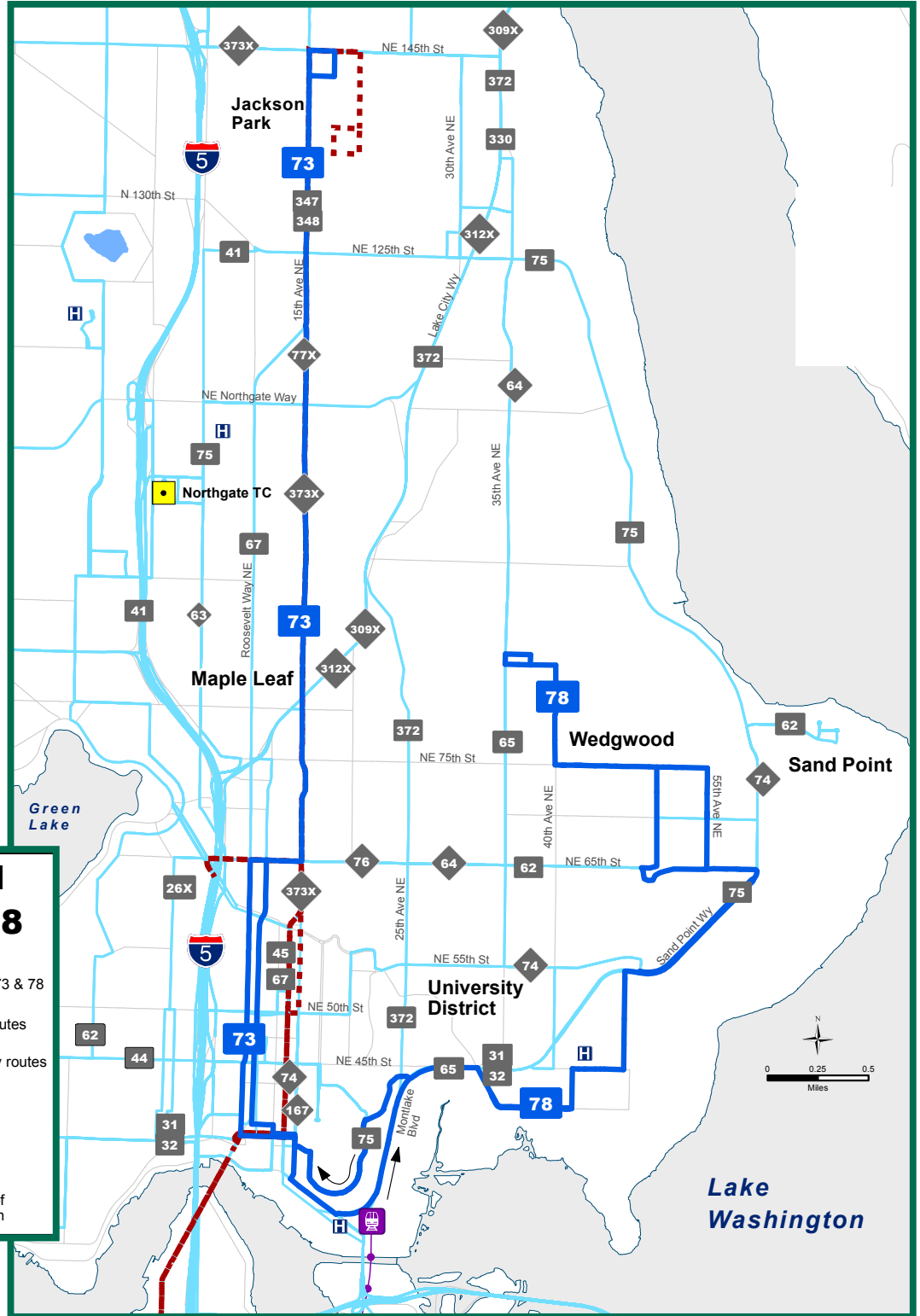

Rider options

- Along University Way, use routes 45 and 67.
- For service between the University District and downtown Seattle, use Link light rail or route 74 (peak periods only).
- For all-day and weekend express service from the Maple Leaf area to downtown Seattle, use Sound Transit Route 522 via new proposed stops at NE 85th Street and Lake City Way NE.
