

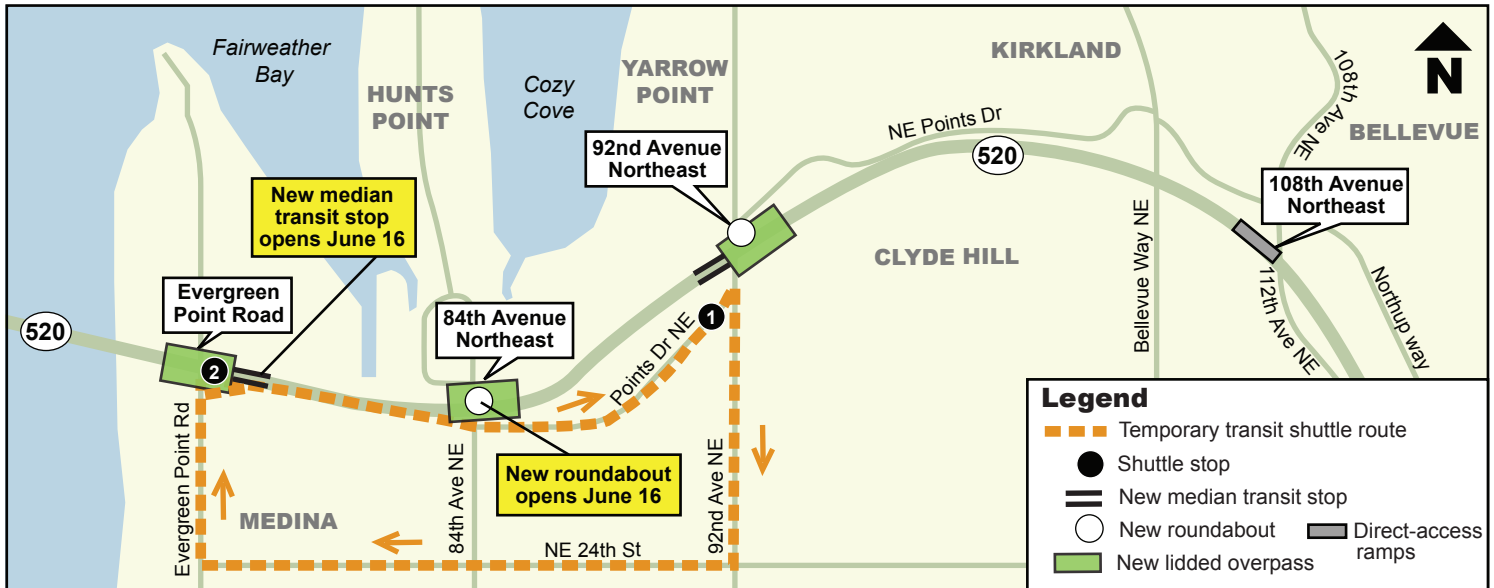

Medina to SR 202: Eastside Transit and HOV Project

New transit stop at Evergreen Point Road opens June 16 June 2014

Temporary shuttle service from 92nd Ave NE; new 84th Ave NE roundabout opens same day



WSDOT and its contractor, Eastside Corridor Constructors, are opening new facilities along SR 520 as they are completed this summer. See details below:

Monday, June 16

- New Evergreen Point Road median transit stops open.
- Current 92nd Avenue Northeast outside stops close until new median stops open there.
- Shuttle service will be provided during commute times.
- New 84th Avenue Northeast roundabout opens.

Late June / early July

- New 92nd Avenue Northeast median transit stops open; temporary shuttle service ends.
- New 108th Avenue Northeast direct-access ramps open for carpools (3+ occupancy) and buses to/from the west.

Later this summer

- New inside transit/HOV lanes open from Medina to I-405 (3+ occupancy).
- New 92nd Avenue Northeast roundabout opens.

Temporary shuttle information

The 92nd Avenue Northeast transit stops close on June 16, when the new Evergreen Point Road median stops open.

A temporary shuttle will be provided to transport local Eastside riders between 92nd Ave NE and Evergreen Pt Rd.

Dates: June 16 through late June / early July.

Times: 5:30 to 9:30 a.m. and 3 to 7 p.m., Mon. through Fri.

Shuttle stop locations:

- 1 Points Drive Northeast at 92nd Avenue Northeast
- 2 Evergreen Point Road Park and Ride on new lid

Note: Shuttle runs in a loop every 10-15 minutes.
