



Free Real-Time Ridesharing to your local Park & Ride



TripPool is neighbors carpooling to the Park & Ride together in a Metro van using a smartphone app to coordinate rides in real time. TripPool vans get a reserved parking spot at the Park & Ride.

Quick Tips To Get Started

1. Download the iCarpool App

Visit www.iCarpool.com to get the app and learn more about the service. Download and install the app on phone.


2. Get \$25 in Free Ride Credits

For a limited time, iCarpool is providing \$25 in ride credits just for downloading the app. After installing, go to the payment screen and enter ICARPOOL25 in the promo code area.



3. Create and Link your Ridematch Account – Get \$25 More Free Ride Credits

TripPool provides a connection to transit on the home end for commuters. By creating a free account at www.RideshareOnline.com, riders can use TripPool for the price of a bus fare.



Once your account is created (or if you have an existing account), simply go to the 'My Account' section of your Profile and select the option to link accounts.


Once you do this, you will be eligible for another \$25 in free ride credits from Metro.

TripPool riders who link their accounts will be reimbursed for any iCarpool charges beyond a one-zone peak bus fare (currently \$2.75) **However, if you have an ORCA card, you can be reimbursed completely!**

4. Provide ORCA Card Number

Additionally, TripPool riders who provide an ORCA card number when they link their accounts will have 100% of their iCarpool charges reimbursed.

Simply input your ORCA card number when prompted during the account linking process to be eligible for full reimbursement for all TripPool trips.
