Summary of proposed changes

- Shorten Route 8 to run between the Central District and Seattle Center to improve reliability.
- Buses would come more often on weekdays.
- This route would have improved service thanks to Seattle voters.

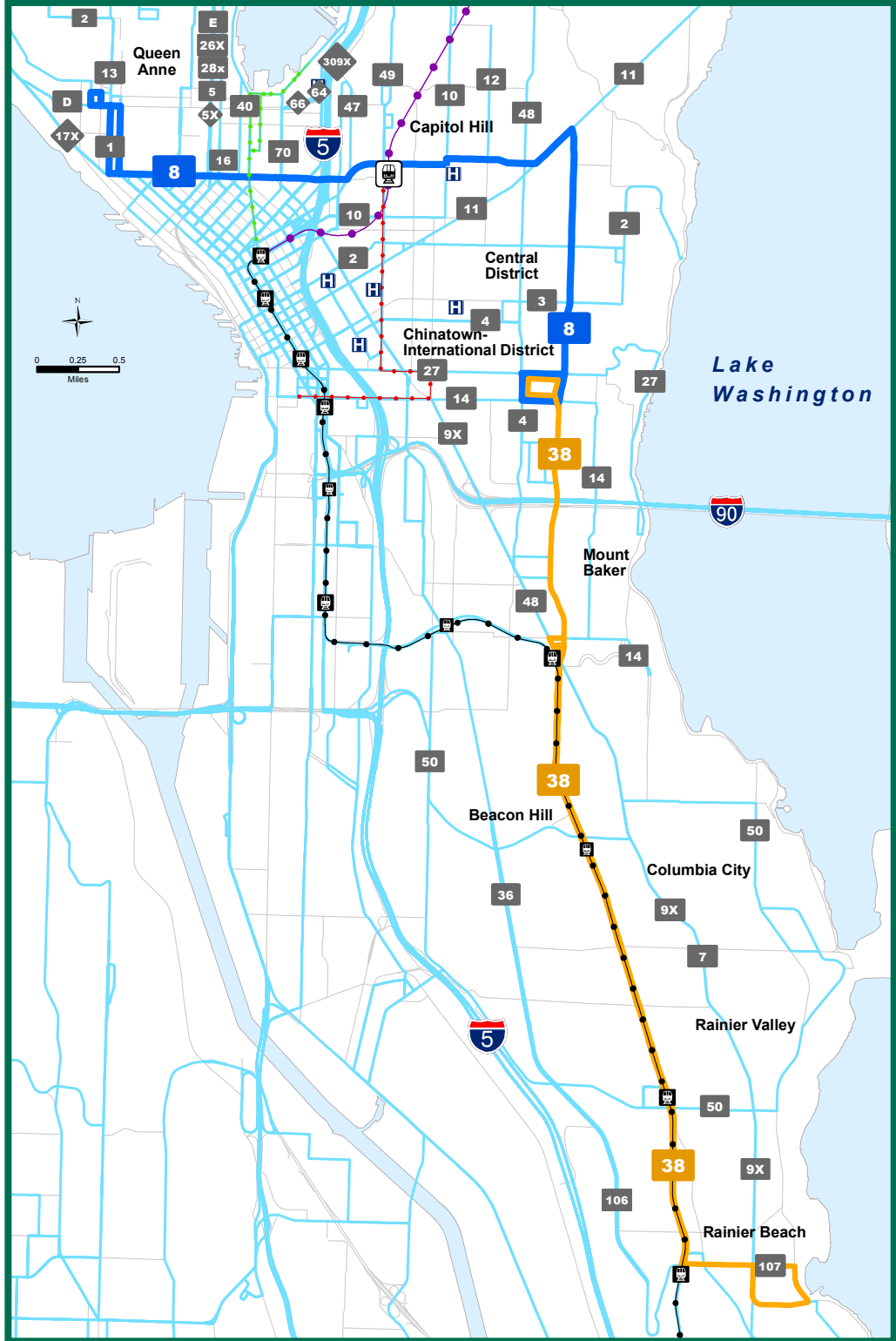
